## Holiday Giving Tree:

- Jen Chambers and Katie Gorman will be chairing this event.
- The PTO will be asking parents for money/donations, then they will purchase gift cards for teachers and staff.
- Last year, PTO collected enough money so that each staff member received $\$ 20$ in gift cards.
- Discussed that it is easiest to collect cash from parents, then distribute evenly to all, rather than asking for specific items for each staff member.
- Jen and Katie will put together an email that will be sent out to parents in the next few weeks so parents can starting sending in donations.


## Bake Sales:
